AECG – ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHY SKILLS FOR HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONALS

Aims and Competencies

The aim of the course is to acquaint students with basic knowledge of ECG reading. Students will learn the main features of ECG tracings: assessment of rhythm, calculating heart rate, observing P-wave forms, measurement of ECG intervals and segments and the evaluation of other relevant waves. Students will be able to recognize obvious arrhythmias and realize significant ECG changes for other cardiac diseases.

Aims and Competencies

The aim of the course is to acquire deeper knowledge and practical skills in otorhinolaryngology. Classical specialized nursing issues are augmented by questions concerning operations, by organizational, social and legal questions, communication with the patient and by nurse-doctor collaboration. During the practice sessions, students will master fundamentals of otoscopy, pharyngoscopy and rhinoscopy, they will actively participate in the operating theatre, they will observe and possibly help with the work in the inpatient department and in the outpatient department.

Aims and Competencies

The course AIM is composed of 4 individual courses, varied in time frames and credits (AIM 1, AIM 2, AIM 3, and AIM 4). The courses may be combined, but each course can be signed up only once!

Maximum hourly dotation of clinical placement in AIM is 320h.

The aim of the course is to gain experience from the clinical practice, which will enable the student to appreciate cultural differences in meeting the needs of women, pregnant women and newborn infants. Students will complete his/her internship on placements that correspond with their specialization, they will learn about the healthcare system in the Czech Republic, they will become acquainted with standards and regulations regarding the provision of midwifery care, and will be able to assess and critically evaluate cultural similarities and differences in midwifery practice.
